<p>Notes for RICHARD DANIEL MURPHY II: [Handwritten Notes by Steven Myers pg. 12:] House burnt down January 15, 1919, 3 am no snow on the ground - moved back in April 1919 - lumber from Webster with chestnut inside - John D. Murphy Rented on East Church Street during cleanup - usually for seasonal help for Crosman Canning from Buffalo/farmerettes - girls from Rochester Normal School would live there. Had a fully equipped library, too. Also had sheets and everything. Farmerettes returned in June - Mary Burns Dick and son, John D. and Jim and Joe went to see Willie near Utica in 1923 - John D. Dick was a redhead. He raised the family barn when he was 20 or 22 years old (about 1894) John's father Richard bought Jim's farm on Whitney Rd.
